
Windows CE is a line of operating systems based on the Windows NT kernel and first released in 1996. It was designed for more rugged hardware than the desktop-oriented Windows NT line, particularly small, portable devices such as handheld computers and PDAs. The last version of Windows CE was 6.0 from 2006 which has been discontinued from support by Microsoft in December 2013. Its successor is Windows Embedded Compact, which only targets custom applications that are already integrated with a vendor or OEM specific hardware appliance. Windows CE 6.0 is the last release of Windows CE 6.0. The operating system provides for limited support to connected biological devices (PDA, cellular phones, medical equipment, etc.) to communicate with other devices over the Internet. Windows Embedded Compact 6 also introduces several important features that were missing in previous versions. For example, in previous versions of Windows CE the only way to install 3rd party applications was by using ActiveSync or PCSync software. Not all mobile devices have ActiveSync available for them, so the new Windows Embedded Compact 6 allows for applications to be installed via simple image files (.WIM format). Windows Embedded Compact 6 also introduces support for additional built in features, such as 3D graphics acceleration. This feature has been available before in Windows CE with the addition of a hardware accelerator card, but now it is built into the operating system itself.

On March 31, 2010 the FIC (Fujitsu) company released an information bulletin, according to which Windows CE 6 is not supported on the "hardware platform with Intel Atom N270 CPU". As of January 1, 2012, Fujitsu updates the list of the "currently not supported hardware platforms" for Windows Embedded CE 6.0 to include newer processors including Intel Atom N475 and Intel Celeron M410. Microsoft has discontinued support for Windows CE 6.0 in December 2013. Windows CE 6.0 does not support third-party access to system resources through the "Win32 API." This means that no 3rd party printer drivers or scanner drivers can be implemented in Windows CE 6.0. However, some devices are bundled with their own proprietary software that will work with Windows CE 6.0, including some modems and some graphics cards/chipsets.

Microsoft Security Essentials is supported only on Windows Embedded CE 6.0 R3 and later releases of Windows Embedded Compact 6.
